

About the Book

The book *Gyan ki Rajniti: Samaj Adhyyan aur Bhartiya Chintan* by Manindra Nath Thakur challenges dominant conceptions about Indian knowledge by distinguishing between Indian and Hindu knowledge, questioning the Hindutva narrative that all Indian knowledge is rooted in Hindu religious terms.
